Facilitators are responsible for hosting short- and long-term workshops and programs, leading group work and meaningful and engaging discussions with youth between the ages of 13-29. Facilitators will host workshops within the organization as well as workshops for other organizations, school institutions and community agencies. Facilitators report to the program manager.

Key responsibilities/duties include:

- Deliver educational and training workshops to youth participating in our and eternal programs
- Prepare and develop materials for group sessions
- Ensure feedback forms are distributed and maintained post workshops
- Complete training and engage in continuous learning as directed by the Program manager
- Be present in monthly/bi-monthly team meetings
- Adhere to policies and procedures, especially respecting guidelines relating to diversity and Anti-Black Racism

Ideal candidate

- Excellent interpersonal, communication and written skills
- Passion working with Black communities, specifically Black youth
- Self-motivated and ability to take initiative
- Knowledge of historic and present issues identified within Black communities and the effects of Anti-Black Racism on Black youth
- The ability to exhibit high energy and to motivate and inspire youth, educators, and professionals
- Comfort in working with a remote team, often independently
- Ability to receive implement feedback and coaching
- Experience using Zoom online platform
- Experience leading group discussions and activities
- Advanced skills in conflict resolution

- Excellent problem-solving skills
- Extensive experience working with Black youth or other racialized communities.
